- 2. Data that can take on any value e.g. time and height.
- 6. Data with numbers in it e.g. time, height, shoe size, age. Can be discrete or continuous.
- 7. Takes information that somebody else has already found.
- 8. Data where you can't have 'in-between' values e.g. How many children you have.

Down

- 1. Not a number, often descriptive e.g. colour or make of car.
- 3. Data you have collected yourself e.g. through questionnaires etc.
- 4. Name of data that has been put into groups e.g. things put into solid, liquids and gases.
- 5. Combination of two variables (values) e.g. you might have age and weight.
