favourites. He made most of his money trade and through activities

of the Elizabethan Court.

**Land:** Elizabeth gave Dudley a great deal

of land and country estates around

Britain.

Info: Dudley had known Elizabeth since

childhood. He was her Master of

Horse. Dudley's young wife Amy Robsart met her death in

suspicious circumstances. He was on

the Privy Council.



## Francis, Duke of Alencon

**Religion**: Catholic

Wealth: He was the brother of the French

King. His family were wealthy. He could create a powerful alliance

with France against Spain.

**Land:** His family were wealthy and he had

a title and many estates in France.

**Info:** French was a Catholic country but

did not hate Protestant England as much as the Spanish. Some people In England would be very angry if Elizabeth married a Catholic. An information leaflet against the marriage was published in England.



## Philip II of Spain.

Religion: Catholic

Wealth: Spain was a very rich country. It

owned a lot of foreign countries and brought back goods (including Gold) f

from South America.

Land: Philip was the King of Spain he

controlled Spain and some other

areas around the world.

Info: Spain had a large army. The Pope
