



ALPHABET PHOTOGRAPHY

HAVE FUN AND BE CREATIVE



Task: To create a full alphabet of 26 individual photos of letters you can see in your surrounding environment.

DURATION: 1 double lesson (to take the photos and upload them) + 1 single lesson (to present them as a grid on a powerpoint slide).

- This task should encourage you to look at things in detail and from different angles (above = bird's eye, upwards= worm's eye) .
- You will need to be creative, inventive and thoughtful.
- You can use a camera phone or a digital SLR.
- You can find your letters around the house, in the garden or on a walk or a combination of all three.
- You are looking for shapes in objects/structures/nature that when viewed from **a certain angle or cropped** make a letter. You are not to just photograph the letter (e.g. on a road sign or poster).
- You can do these in black and white or colour.
- Tip: write out the alphabet and tick them off as you find them. That way you can do them in any order.
- Once you have all 26 upload them and present in a grid on one page (this is probably easiest to do in powerpoint). Print and stick into your sketchbook on the page after the 'ART & TEXT' moodboard. If you do not have a printer just save the powerpoint slide as a digital file.
- Keep digital copies of the individual letters as we will be using them for future tasks.
