# Cognitive Explanations of Schizophrenia

## **Explanation**

- Acknowledges role of biological factors in causing sensory symptoms of sz
- Further features exist due to individuals attempting to understand the biological ones, and faulty cognitions lead to a cognitive overload
- The SZ turns to other people for validation of their thoughts/ experiences, but once they fail to confirm the validity the sz believes that others are hiding the truth and become withdrawn and paranoid

# Cognitive Behavioural Therapy (CBT)

- Adjust faulty thought patterns and beliefs
- Traces origins of symptoms, evaluate content of delusions and rationally test validity of beliefs
- Patients encouraged to develop alternatives

Outcome studies suggest CBT patients have fewer hallucinations and recover to a greater extent than those on antipsychotics

Expensive & time consuming

Requires engagement with therapy

Doesn't treat negative symptoms

#### Positives:)

- + Meyer-Lindenberg et al (2002): link between excess dopamine in the prefrontal cortex and working memory
- +<u>Neufeld (1978)</u>: SZ took longer to encode stimuli and showed worse STM than control group
- +Practical Application: CBT.

### **Negatives**:(

- Not that much empirical support
- Can cause and effect between faulty cognitions and sz be established from research?
- Explanation explains symptoms but not the cause so well
  - + Though assumes biological causes (diathesis-stress model)
- Ethical issues: studies just measure effectiveness of CBT, don't actually try to raise treatment effectiveness
