

Stalin Writes On Polish Question

LONDON, Sat.: The "Daily Mail's" diplomatic correspondent states that Marshal Stalin has written a letter to Mr. Churchill regarding the Polish situation, believed to be reiterating the Soviets' desire for a strong and independent Poland with a settlement of the border problem on the basis of the Curzon Line.

The Note also contained other suggestions dealing with the situation.

The Polish Government in London has been informed of the contents of the letter and is now considering the matter. Stalin's action was in response to a personal note from Mr. Churchill.
