

## Lesson18 I like milk the most

### Part 1 Objectives

Topic: Shopping

Key vocabulary: 鸡蛋、牛奶、菜、最、卖、两、斤、一共

Grammar Point: Using “最(zuì)” to form the superlative of an adjective (best, worst, biggest, smallest, etc.)

Chinese		English	Examples
jīdàn 鸡蛋	n.	egg	e.g. 我每天都吃一个鸡蛋。 (I eat an egg every day.)
niúniǎi 牛奶	n.	milk	e.g. 家里没有牛奶了，你可以去买吗？ (There is no milk at home, can you buy some milk?)
cài 菜	n.	dishes; food	e.g. 他喜欢吃中国菜。 (He likes eating Chinese dishes.)
zuì 最	adv.	most	e.g. 你最喜欢的生日礼物是什么？ (What is your favourite birthday gift?)
mài 卖	v.	to sell	e.g. 这个电脑怎么卖？ (How much is this computer?)
liǎng 两	num.	two	e.g. 这儿有两张票，我们去看电影吧！ (Here are two tickets, let's go to watch movies.)
jīn 斤	m.	a unit of weight(500g)	e.g. 苹果多少钱一斤？ (How much is the apple?)
yígòng 一共	adv.	in total	e.g. 教室里一共有五十个学生。 (There are fifty students in the classroom in total.)

#### Version A (Without Pinyin)

中午，妈妈做了很多菜，有羊肉、猪肉，还有牛肉。我最爱吃猪肉，虽然羊肉和牛肉比猪肉贵([gui], expensive)，但是我觉得猪肉最好吃。

下午，我去了商店，我想买衣服，我觉得穿裙子很漂亮，我买了一条裙子，虽然非常贵，但是很好看。

#### Version B (With Pinyin)

早上，我吃了一个鸡蛋，喝了一杯牛奶。我最喜欢喝牛奶，我觉得 niú nǎi hěn hào hē.

牛奶很好喝。

Zhōngwǔ, māma zuò le hěnduō cài, yǒu yáng ròu、zhū ròu, hái yǒu niú ròu. Wǒ zuì ài chī zhū ròu,

中午，妈妈做了很多菜，有羊肉、猪肉，还有牛肉。我最爱吃猪肉，

suī rán yáng ròu hé niú ròu bǐ zhū ròu guì, dàn shì wǒ juéde zhū ròu zuì hào chī.

虽然羊肉和牛肉比猪肉贵([gui], expensive)，但是我觉得猪肉最好吃。

Xiàwǔ, wǒ qù le shāng diàn, wǒ xiǎng mǎi yī fu, Wǒ juéde chuān qún zi hěn piào liang, wǒ mǎi le yì

下午，我去了商店，我想买衣服，我觉得穿裙子很漂亮，我买了一条 tiáo qún zi, suī rán fēi cháng guì, dàn shì hěn hào kàn.

条裙子，虽然非常贵，但是很好看。

	Someone/something	最 zui	Adjective
These clothes are the most beautiful.	zhè xiē yīfu 这些衣服 these clothes		
Omar is the tallest.	Omar		gāo 高。 tall

“最 (zui)” can also come before psychological verbs to express what someone "most likes," "most hates," etc.

English	Chinese			
	Subject	最 zui most	Psychological Verb	Object
I like dogs the most.	Wǒ 我 I			xǐhuan 喜欢 to like
She likes cats the most.	Tā 她 She		ài 爱 to love	māo 猫。 cat

It won't make sense if you try to use “最 (zui)” with non-psychological verbs, though.

More examples:

1. 明天可能下雪，明天最冷。(It is going to snow tomorrow, it is the coldest day.)
2. 你吃过的最好吃的东西是什么？(What is the most delicious food have you eat?)
3. 我最喜欢我的姐姐。(I love my older sister best.)
