早上, 我 吃 了 一 个 鸡蛋, 喝 了 一 杯 牛奶。我 最 喜欢 喝 牛奶, 我 觉得 牛奶 很 好喝。

中午,妈妈做了很多菜,有羊肉、猪肉,还有牛肉。我最爱吃猪肉,虽然羊肉和牛肉比猪肉贵([guì], expensive),但是我觉得猪肉最好吃。

下午, 我去了商店, 我想买衣服, 我觉得穿裙子很漂亮, 我买了一条裙子, 虽然非常贵, 但是很好看。

Version B (With Pinyin)

Wǒ xǐhuan jīntiān, yīnwèi jīntiān shì xīngqī liù.

我喜欢今天,因为今天是星期六。

Zǎoshang, wǒ chī le yí gè jīdàn, hē le yì bēi niúnǎi. Wǒ zuì xǐhuan hē niúnǎi, wǒ juéde 早上,我吃了一个鸡蛋,喝了一杯牛奶。我最喜欢喝牛奶,我觉得niúnǎi hěn hǎohē.

牛奶 很 好喝。

Zhōngwǔ, māma zuò le hěnduō cài, yǒu yángròu、zhūròu, hái yǒu niúròu. Wǒ zuì ài chī zhūròu,中午,妈妈做了很多菜,有羊肉、猪肉,还有牛肉。我最爱吃猪肉,suīrán yángròu hé niúròu bǐ zhūròu guì, dànshì wǒ juéde zhūròu zuì hǎochī.

虽然 羊肉 和 牛肉 比 猪肉 贵([guì], expensive), 但是 我 觉得 猪肉 最 好吃。

These clothes are the most beautiful.	zhè jiàn yīfu 这些衣服 these clothes	这些衣服 zuì		
Omar is the tallest.	Omar		gāo 高。 tall	

"最 (zuì)" can also come before psychological verbs to express what someone "most likes," "most hates," etc.

English	Chinese					
	Subject		Psychological Verb	Object		
I like dogs the most.	Wŏ 我 I	zuì	xǐhuan 喜欢 to like	gǒu 狗。 dog		
She likes cats the most.	Tā 她 She	最 most	ài 爱 to love	māo 貓。 cat		

It won't make sense if you try to use "最 (zuì)" with non-psychological verbs, though.

More examples:

- 1. 明天可能下雪,明天最冷。(It is going to snow tomorrow, it is the coldest day.)
- 2. 你吃过的最好吃的东西是什么? (What is the most delicious food have you eat?)
- 3. 我最喜欢我的姐姐。(I love my older sister best.)
