## **KES 2012 Silver Practice Expedition**

Practice expeditions will take place in the Peak District and due to the large numbers of groups, guide lines have been drawn for the routes.

You will be walking for 3 days.

Day 1 for silver will be planned to be slightly below the required hours to allow training to be completed en-route and additional training after arriving at the campsite. This will involve some additional navigation work, revision of the expedition requirements and a test of waterproofs should the expedition be forecast to be dry!

The following 2 days will be full distance and in increasingly challenging terrain which will prepare you well for your qualifying expeditions in the Lake District.

## Day 1

Birchover Campsite GR 242623 to Greenhills Campsite, GR 201692

You should aim to walk a minimum of 14km over approximately 6hrs, avoiding the use of roads and national trails as much as possible.

## Day 2

Greenhills Campsite to Pindale Farm GR 163825

You must now draw on your map a straight line between these 2 campsites. Plan on walking a minimum of 18km between these 2 sites, and must walk to the west of this straight line.

## Day 3

From Pindale farm you must walk to the finish point the car park at Baslow, GR 258721. You should plan to achieve 18-20km, and stay **east** of the line joining Pindale farm and Greenhills. You should also plan to walk to or past 2 points from each moor listed below:

Remember that these route are to be your practice expedition and you should try to expose yourselves to as many new experiences along the way as possible.
